## LEARN ABOUT YOUR PARKING OPTIONS

Commuters and resident students with a class standing of sophomore and above (30+ credits) are eligible to register for parking. Freshman resident students must apply to park on campus. Planning to live in the apartments immediately adjacent to campus? Commuter registrants may not park or store their vehicles on campus overnight, so consider purchasing an overnight storage permit.
